


Nr. Crt.	Question	Answer
1.	Given the complexity of the study area, the need for multiple analyzes and proposals, we find it insufficient to allocate a single A0 format page to illustrate the master plan, even with a second page fitting to the Zone 2 detail area. We would like to know if the number of master plan pages can be supplemented.	Allocating a too generous representation area often affects the drafting time and is perceived as a disadvantage by many of the potential competitors. The surface proposed in the Competition Brief and the number of plates have resulted from the analysis carried out through consultation with experienced designers, who have participated in this type of competitions. In order to maintain equal opportunities, the participating teams will have to meet the requirements as specified in the Competition Brief and Competition Rules.
2.	Taking into account that the topographic support received does not contain new constructions such as the Stadium, the Polivalenta Hall or the new airport runway in the updated form, as well as other real estate developments made in the last years and adjacent to the study area, we want to know if the exclusive use of the topographic base made available is mandatory or can it be updated?	The base plan used and offered to competitors is the last general plan of the city at this scale. Of course, competitors are free to add to it whatever they think fit to present a more elaborate result to the jury. However, overlays and corrections must be made over the base plan available in the competition documentation.
3.	Within the Competition Brief, page 13, point 3, mention is made of Tineretului Street. We would like a more accurate identification of this street.	The street mentioned in the Competition Brief, page 13, point 3, as the Tineretului Street is in fact called Splaiul Independenței. The name confusion is due to the fact that the street had been called Tineretului for many years, and the competition brief consultant didn't notice the name change. We apologize for this inconvenience!
4.	Does the scale of the fitting plans (corresponding to the master plan and the two areas of detail) remain at the discretion of the competitors?	The scale of the designed elements is specified in the competition brief.
5.	In the Competition Rules, p. 12, point 3.6.2, it is stated that "Each project will include an estimate of the design services and an investment estimate for the two proposed areas for detailing (according to Annex 2 model) but Annex 2 (2.3 Estimate model) contains only the design services estimate. Which is the estimate model for the investment?"	The design cost estimate model/layout must be filled-in, signed and placed into the sealed envelope; this stands as a basis for the negotiation with the winner for the signing of the design contract. (Model Annex 2)  The design cost estimate and the investment cost estimate for the two areas proposed for detailing must also be handed over as contest pieces - in the tube next to the plates (Warning! These must not contain identification elements of the competitor - signature, stamp, company logo etc.)  The investment cost estimate model/layout is left to the competitor's choice.

6.	In the Competition Brief, page 18, point 4 "Award criteria" is presented a breakdown of the score. We ask for further details on the points quantification of aspects numbered A1-A6 and B1-B5.	The award criteria are those presented in the Competition Brief.
7.	According to the Competition Rules, p. 17, point 3.18.1, possible differences between the two contractual parties are mentioned. Please explain further from a legal perspective the possible disputes that may trigger this article.	We will come back with additional information on this point.
8.	We ask to expedite the cut-off date of the receipt of questions Round 2 / answer for questions Round 2 We consider that the period of one week remaining until the actual deadline is insufficient as regards to the modification of the contest solution already in an advanced stage.	The cut-off date/deadline until which questions can be asked is set by the legislation in force. We will supplement with an intermediate round of questions and answers. Deadline for receiving questions for the Intermediate Round - August 20th, 2017 Deadline for answers to questions for the Intermediate Round - August 25th, 2017
9.	In the 'Explanatory Situation Plan' three sections of the river surface are marked as areas of 'opportunity for linking the banks'. Does this opportunity mean a physical connection such as a bridge?	We consider the results of this contest to be essential for opening discussions on all possibilities and opportunities for the development and improvement of the river course. These may be applicable in the short, medium or long term. Looking at things from this perspective, competitors are invited to identify these opportunities. Those specified in the Explanatory Situation Plan are opportunities identified by analyzes of the different entities consulted in the elaboration of the Competition Brief. In the cases noted, the physical connection of the two banks was considered welcomed.
10.	To what extent and where are new crossings allowed along the urban tract of the river?	The crossing system of the river is specified in the General Urban Plan. But we welcome the possible proposals within the overall vision that will facilitate the opening of discussions and the analysis of their real opportunity.
11.	Are there any sections of the river currently navigable for recreational purposes?	The physical characteristics of the river course in Cluj Napoca (sudden fluctuations in flow, use of water for Hidroelectrica, the large quantity of floating materials brought by water etc.) determined the Authorities not to allow the use of the water course for waterborne or recreational activities. Wetland areas where the watercourse exceeds the minimum section of the river (the product of the width and height of this section) could be reconsidered in the idea of

		creating new functions for the river. We consider the contest to be a good tool to open a discussion by identifying these opportunities.
12.	Are there any areas where swimming is currently safe and allowed in the river? Is this a desired public amenity?	Bathing in the Someșul Mic river is very unpractical. The river is quite fast, the flow can grow unexpectedly, it is a cold-water river (it collects water from mountain areas) and the water is far from being perfectly clean. But where the water is shallow (in the Grigorescu Beach area, for example), people are often tempted to get their feet in the water. However, identifying solutions to allow water to be diverted and filtered on proposed new portions could facilitate the use of river water for swimming, bathing and canoeing.
13.	Can you provide a map of the Natura 2000 sites mentioned in the excerpt from the Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan?	 <p>The map displays the boundaries of Natura 2000 sites in the Cluj-Napoca region.
