Irina Băncescu (Constanta, 1978), Dr. Arch. is an Assistant Professor at the Department of Architecture History & Theory and Patrimony Conservation, UAUIM, Bucharest. In 2012 she finished her PhD with the subject "On waterfronts. Aspects of the Romanian seaside evolution in the communist period" at UAUIM. She published numerous studies and articles focusing, among other, on the development of port cities in the postindustrial period, urban history of coastal settlements, industrial port heritage, seaside tourism, investigating case studies from the Romanian coast.
