

Dimitra Theochari – Short Bio

Dimitra Theochari is a licensed architect, engineer, and landscape architect in Greece, Germany and the UK with extensive experience of a wide variety of cultures and international working environments and who has worked in or led over 110 projects in 16 different countries in 3 continents. She has a 10-year experience working in landscape architecture in medium, larger and XL scale projects from the masterplan scale to design implementation. She has studied Architecture and Structural Engineering in the National Technical University of Athens, Greece, and Landscape Architecture in The University of Texas at Austin, in Texas in the USA.

As a young landscape architect Dimitra worked in Turenscape in Beijing, one of the most famous and awarded Chinese landscape architecture companies. Her transition to the European context happened while working for a small Swiss architecture and landscape architecture office in the Swiss Alps, VWA Architects, for whom she designed the AgroparcBernex project, that was a winning entry for a competition of 9 ha productive landscape park in the peri urban area of Geneva. She continued her career as a project manager for almost 6 years in Ramboll Studio Dreiseitl, when she focused on climate adaptation, water-sensitive urban design, ecological landscape planning, nature-based solutions, liveable cities design, and circular city design from the perspective of the built environment, river restoration and ecosystem restoration in over 55 landscape architecture projects of different scales.

Currently, Dimitra is working for MERA Landschaftsarchitekten, a medium sized landscape architecture company focused on projects in the Hamburg area and is currently developing the portfolio of the company for masterplan projects and competitions.
